NOTICE - DUE TO THE ELECTRONIC VOTE-COUNTING SYSTEM, THE BALLOT INSTRUCTIONS WILL READ:

1. TO VOTE YOU MUST BLACKEN THE OVAL COMPLETELY. An oval blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.
2. To vote for a person whose name is NOT on the ballot, you must blacken the oval completely to the left of the line provided and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.
3. If you make a mistake, ask for a new ballot.
4. Use only a black ink pen.
5. Do not fold the ballot unless voting by absentee or mail-in.

Official Pre-Canvass Meeting Notice

Public notice is hereby given that the Adams County Pre-Canvass Meeting will occur at 7:00 a.m. on November 5, 2024 in the Voter Registration Office at 230 Greenmyer Lane, Gettysburg, for purpose of pre-canvassing the ballots. No members of the general public will be permitted to observe the pre-canvass in person, and only one authorized representative from each candidate in an election and one representative from each political party shall be permitted to remain in the room in which the absentee and mail-in ballots are pre-canvassed. CDC guidelines will be strictly followed, and all representatives will be required to follow County sanitation protocols if appearing in person. Representatives will have the option of viewing the pre-canvass meeting through the Microsoft Teams online software. You will be able to watch a live feed of the process and interact with County staff through Microsoft Teams. The parties and candidates should email Sean Mott, First Assistant County Solicitor, at samott@adamscountypa.gov to register their representatives and to receive the Microsoft Teams link.

The County Board of Elections will meet at 9:00 a.m. Friday, November 8, 2024 to compute and pre-canvas the returns of the General Election.
