Donald G. Oyler, an esteemed member of the Adams County Bar and Editor of the Adams County Legal Journal since its inception in 1959, died July 24, 1998, at the age of 72. Mr. Oyler was admitted to the Adams County Bar on September 21, 1953. He practiced in the law firm of Wolf & Oyler for most of his legal career, and served as Solicitor to the Borough of Gettysburg for well over 36 years. He was known as a proficient practitioner and a scholarly researcher. Indeed, Donald G. Oyler served his Bar Association, his clients, and his community with great distinction. His absence at the Adams County Bar will be sorely felt.
