

Conserving Natural Resources for Our Future

Adams County Conservation District historically has partnered with local volunteers to construct rain barrels made from reused food grade barrels. More recently, our District staff has been constructing the rain barrels that we sell. The barrels are black pickle barrels, approximately 55 gallons, with lids that screw on, and have a screen on them to prevent mosquito breeding. There is a drain on the bottom where a hose can be hooked up, and a standard spigot where a bucket can be filled. There is also an overflow hose to control extra water when the barrel is full.

Blue bird boxes are premium cedar and treated with protective stain. Included are air vents, clean-out-doors, a rust-free galvanized elevate wire mesh floor, predator guards and fledgling kerfs for extra grip. The boxes help prevent and reduce competition from both European house sparrows and starlings.

The bat boxes' interior is a rough cedar and grooved for clinging. A Saturday hanger hook lets you easily mount it to a pole, tree, or wall. Holds up to 40+ bats. Whether you want to exclude bats from your house or attract bats, you can provide them with a safe and suitable alternate home with the pre-assembled bat boxes. One bat is capable of capturing 500-1,000 insects per hour. Bats eat many backyard pests and also consume insects detrimental to farm crops.
