ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 25th day of March, 2009, in consideration of Administrative Order No. 10 of 2003, dated March 17, 2003, which created a Processing Center Fee of \$125.00, and Act 81 of 2008, 42 Pa. C.S.A. §1725.5, effective March 24, 2009, which authorizes the creation of a booking center fund, the Court hereby directs that:

1. Administrative Order No. 10 of 2003 is rescinded, effective immediately, except to the extent of the collection of such fees previously imposed.
2. Effective immediately, every defendant
 - a. Placed on probation without verdict pursuant to 35 P.S. §780-117, or
 - b. Entered into the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program for, or pleads guilty to or nolo contendere to, or is convicted of, a crime constituting a misdemeanor or felony under the Crimes Code (Title 18), the Vehicle Code (Title 75), or the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act (Title 35) shall be required to pay a Booking Center Fee of \$300.00.
3. The Booking Center Fee shall be included with any application for admission into the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program. The Clerk of Courts shall automatically assess the fee when a person is

entered into the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program,
accepted for probation without verdict, or sentenced by the court.

4. The Clerk of Courts shall periodically transfer the Booking Center Fee to the County of Adams for deposit into a booking center fund established by the County Commissioners. Funds so deposited shall be used solely for the operation and maintenance of a booking center at the Adams County Adult Correctional Complex.
5. Fees collected under Administrative Order No. 10 of 2003, not already distributed, shall be placed into the County's booking center fund.
6. No fees deposited into the County's booking center fund shall be withdrawn until the County's booking center plan has been certified by the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime & Delinquency.
