5 **ORDER OF COURT**

6 AND NOW, this 2nd day of May, 2023, in reference to the Work Release Building at the Adams
7 County Adult Correctional Complex, it is Ordered:

- 8 1. Administrative Order 33 of 2007, which transferred supervision of the Work Release Building
9 to what was previously known as the Adams County Adult Probation and Parole Department, is
10 vacated, effective May 3, 2023. All supervision responsibilities of this location are returned to
11 the Adams County Prison Board as of the effective date.
- 12 2. Administrative Order 51 of 2010, which established a laundry fee and drug testing fee for those
13 housed at the Re-Entry Facility, is vacated effective May 3, 2023. Fees assessed in individual
14 cases prior to the effective date of this Order shall continue to be assessed and collected in
15 those individual cases.
- 16 3. By August 31, 2023, Court Administration shall work cooperatively with County Officials to
17 complete transferring funds held by the Court pursuant to Administrative Order 10 of 2022 and
18 specifically for the account known as the "Court Commissary Fund Account", to the County
19 and to a location as determined by the County Commissioners. The Court Administrator shall
20 notify this Court of completion of said transfer, at which time, the Court shall then address
21 Administrative Order 10 of 2022 in this regard.
