Number 12 of 2011**

ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 15th day of April, 2011, pursuant to 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 9728, Act 181 of 1990, as amended, and with the designation of the Adams County Commissioners as evidenced by Attachment A, it is hereby Ordered that the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office is designated as collection agent for all purposes set forth in 42 Pa. C.S.A. § 9728. It is further Ordered that the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office is designated as assignee for all judgments entered in favor of the Adams County Department of Probation Services. As such, the Clerk of Courts Office is authorized to enter of record judgments for restitution, reparation, fees, costs, fines, penalties, and all other fees and charges imposed by Court Order pursuant to statutory law or Administrative Order in all adult criminal and juvenile delinquency cases.

In adult criminal matters, the Clerk of Courts shall enter judgment in any case where the defendant owes more than \$500 and has not paid all financial obligations in full within thirty (30) days of entry of the Order directing such payment. Judgments in juvenile matters shall only be entered upon receipt of memorandum from the Department of Probation Services indicating the caption and amount of judgment. All judgments entered shall be entered in favor of the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office. Judgments shall be entered by filing the same with the Adams County Prothonotary's Office.

1 It is further Ordered that the Adams County Clerk of Courts Office shall
2 provide appropriate documentation to the Adams County Prothonotary's Office
3 to satisfy all judgments entered pursuant to this Order once an account is paid in
4 full. Judgments shall be marked satisfied no later than thirty (30) days after an
5 account has been settled.
