IT Update

The Information Technology Department recently completed Cyber Awareness Training for 32 County, Courts, and Elected offices. The Cyber Awareness Training was completed from March to July 2024, starting with the Elections and Voter Registration office and concluding with the Commissioners' Department. Trainings were primarily completed in person, however a cybersecurity recording of the content was provided for those who were not able to attend. Feedback was overwhelmingly positive, and departments were appreciative of the in-house cybersecurity training. Preserving Adams County Natural Heritage Areas

At a recent public meeting, the Board of Commissioners recently approved the
Adams County Natural Heritage Areas Agreement with the Appalachian Trail Conservancy. This Agreement provides that the County will award matching funds in the

amount of \$16,750.00 along with York, Cumberland, and Franklin Counties for the purpose of updating the Natural Heritage Inventories in each of the Counties. This Agreement is effective July 17, 2024, and expires January 1, 2027.

Employee Health Benefits Package Approved For 3 Years

Employee Health Insurance is very important to most staff members and is a critical element in hiring and retention of staff. At the July 24th Commissioners public meeting, the Administrative Services Only (ASO) Group Contract Declaration Page with Capital Blue-Cross, regarding the administration of employee health benefits in 2024 was approved.

The ASO Group Contract that was approved is an agreement for Capital BlueCross to administer health benefits on behalf of the County as described in the Plan. The term of the ASO Agreement for Group Preferred Provider Benefits and Rx Card Plan Benefits is three (3) years, commencing on January 1, 2024, and terminating on December 31, 2026. The term of the ASO Agreement for Vision Benefits is two (2) years, commencing on January 1, 2024, and terminating on December 31, 2025, and Group Preferred Provider Benefits, General benefits coverage, and administrative procedures under the PPO Plans for union and non-union employees, including the RX Card Plan & Vision Benefits Plan, were also addressed in the agreement.
