The funds shall be expended for the enforcement of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania which are criminal in nature and can be catagorized as summary offenses, misdemeanors and felonies. It shall be used to augment existing programs or to purchase and fund new programs but shall not be used to supplant and replace pre-existing funding from other fees or tax revenues.
