Mount Joy Township ASA Review - Kinsella

Staff Update

Community Development Block Grant Update

Mr. Lawson provided an update on projects that have been chosen for 2021 funding allocations. These projects include:

- Biglerville Borough: \$10,000 for waterline replacement
- Hoffman Homes: \$85,000 for water and sewer system
- <u>East Berlin Borough:</u> \$36,000 for ADA compliant parking space and walkway at borough building
- <u>YWCA:</u> \$26,000 to be used for scholarships for enrollment fees
- <u>Adams County Arts Council:</u> \$16,000 for therapeutic arts classes for eligible populations
