5 **ORDER OF COURT**

6 AND NOW, this 25th day of April, 2023, it is hereby Ordered:

- 7 1. All divorce officer hearings conducted by court-appointed officers shall be held in the
8 Adams County Courthouse in Courtroom 4 on Thursdays of each respective week.
9 Scheduling for divorce officer hearings shall be arranged by the court-appointed officer
10 with the Court Administrator's Office;
- 11 2. All divorce officer hearings shall be considered a hearing before a court of record with the
12 proceedings digitally recorded. Upon scheduling of a divorce officer hearing, the Court
13 Administrator's Office shall make arrangements for necessary personnel to digitally record
14 the proceeding. Private stenographers shall not be utilized for purposes of maintaining the
15 Hearing record;
- 16 3. All requests for transcripts from divorce officer hearing proceedings shall be made pursuant
17 to Local Rules of Judicial Administration 4007, 4008, 4009, and 4011. In the event the
18 presiding court-appointed officer requires preparation of transcript to assist in preparing a
19 recommendation, the court-appointed officer shall make the request as described in Local
20 Rules of Judicial Administration 4007, with said request to be reviewed by the Family Law
21 Administrative Judge and if approved, the court-appointed officer shall not be assessed a
22 fee to receive the transcript.

23 This Order shall be effective immediately. Administrative Order 11 of 2019 is hereby

24 VACATED.
