Court Administration:

Recommendation from Court Administrator Don Fennimore, and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners designate Chairman Randy L. Phiel to approve the quotation from Thomson Reuters, a Canadian company, for renewal of the County's Westlaw subscription. Westlaw is used for legal research by the Courts, Magistrate District Judges, Solicitor's Office, District Attorney's Office, and Domestic Relations. The term of the Agreement is one (1) year, commencing on June 1, 2023 and terminating on May 31, 2024. Total cost to the County is \$23,885.04.

Office of the Coroner:

Recommendation from Coroner Patricia Felix, and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners approve the following:

- Designate Chairman Randy L. Phiel to approve the invoice from Hopkins Software Solutions, of Commodore, PA, for renewal of the Coroner's H.A.N.D. Notify Access. This software provides notification of Hospice and nursing home deaths directly to the Coroner's office. It is further recommended that the Board sign the Addendum to the End User Licensing Agreement, which incorporates the County's standard terms and conditions into the Agreement. The term of the Agreement is one (1) year, commencing on April 3, 2023 and terminating on April 2, 2024. Total cost to the County is \$350.00.
- Ratify the signature of Coroner Patricia Felix, dated September 26, 2022, on the Work Statement from the Pennsylvania Department of Health Prescription Drug Monitoring Program ("PDMP"). This Agreement provides that the Coroner's office will submit coroner reports and toxicology reports for overdose deaths, violent

deaths, and maternal deaths in Adams County to the PDMP for purposes of monitoring and mitigation. In return, PDMP shall pay to Adams County \$10,000.00 for the submission of reports dating July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

IT Department:

Recommendation from Phil Walter, CIO and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners ratify the signature and approval by Chairman Randy L. Phiel of the Quote from Hull's Electric Service, of Gettysburg, to clean the servers, routers, and battery back-up units in the main server room and two network switch closets. Cleaning of these areas is necessary due to accumulation of debris from the welding which was performed on the HSB roof. It is further recommended that the Board approve the Terms and Conditions between Hull's and the County. This quote is effective March 10, 2023. The total cost for this work is \$1,420.00.

Ag Land Preservation:

Recommendation from Ellen Dayhoff, Rural Resource Manager, and after review by Solicitor Molly R. <u> Planning – Community Development Block Grant:</u>

Recommendation from Deana Duvall, Grants Coordinator, and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners approve and authorize Chairman Randy L. Phiel to sign the Revision Request for 2019 CDBG OBO Littlestown and 2020 CDBG OBO (C-000080369) Littlestown Curb Ramp projects. This request is to change locations for Littlestown Curb Ramp Projects.

Building and Maintenance:

Recommendation from Larry Steinour, Director and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners ratify the signature and approval by Chairman Randy L. Phiel of the Quote from PROAC Corporation, of Bethel, PA, for cleaning the internal duct work within the IT server room air handler unit, which has debris from the internal welding work that was performed on the HSB roof. It is further recommended that the Board approve the Terms and Conditions between PROAC and the County. This quote is effective March 10, 2023. Total cost to the County is \$2,145.00.

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Human Resources:

Recommendation from Michelle Miller, Director and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners ratify the signature of Solicitor Molly R. Mudd on an Engagement Letter for Professional Services with Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott, LLC of Pittsburgh for an operational audit of the county's HIPAA privacy Policies and Procedures. Deliverables will include review of existing HIPAA privacy and security policies, review and update cyber incident assessment, breach response, notification and mitigation procedures, preparation of an online training tool, and an on-site training session. The cost of these services is a flat fee of \$16,500, which will be paid through a PCorp Loss Control Grant.

Public Defender:

Recommendation from Chief Public Defender Scott Harper, and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners designate Chairman Randy L. Phiel to sign the License Agreement with LegalEdge Software. LegalEdge will provide case management software for the Public Defender's office and migrate the data from the Public Defender's previous case management system, which is being decommissioned. The term of the Agreement is one (1) year and shall commence upon the "go-live" date. Total cost to the County is \$23,000.00.

Adams County Adult Correctional Complex:

Recommendation from Warden Katy Hileman, and after review by Solicitor Molly R. Mudd, that the Board of Commissioners approve the following:

- Designate Chairman Randy L. Phiel to sign the quote from Governmentjobs.com, Inc., D/B/A NEOGOV, a California company, for renewal of the ACACC's PowerDMS software. PowerDMS is the ACACC's policy management software and allows the ACACC to provide documentation to the Pennsylvania Department of Corrections for Title 37 Inspections. It is further recommended that the Board sign the Addendum to the Services Agreement, which incorporates the County's standard terms and conditions into the Agreement. The term of the Agreement is one (1) year, commencing April 24, 2023 and terminating April 23, 2024. Total cost to the County is \$10,613.96.
- Designate Chairman Randy L. Phiel to sign the Estimate from On the Fly Pest Solutions, Inc., a Maryland Company, for pest control services at the ACACC. It is further recommended that the Board sign the Terms and Conditions between On the Fly and the County. The term of the Agreement is one (1) year, commencing March 22, 2023 and terminating March 21, 2024. Total cost to the County is \$3,393.72.
