- **2026 Medication-Assisted Substance Use Treatment Grant (ID# 48614):** This application was completed and sent to the Solicitor's office for legal review. Adams County's total allocation for this noncompetitive grant opportunity was \$97,960.00. The deadline to submit this application is April 16, 2026, with an expected project start date of July 1, 2026, and an end date of June 30, 2028.
 - The application is for \$97,953.00 to cover costs associated with medication and the annual subscription for the Carey Guide, which is used to deliver immediate cognitive behavioral interventions based on an individual's criminogenic and substance use risk and needs.
