WHAT IS THE EMERGENCY RIDE HOME PROGRAM:

Our Emergency Ride Home (ERH) program is a free reimbursement for a ride home from work or school in the event of a qualified emergency. The ERH program is for commuters using a green mode to travel to work or school.

An Emergency Ride Home is available to those who:

- ✓ Are enrolled in Commute PA prior to the emergency situation
- ✓ Have a completed profile with home and work locations
- \checkmark Are recording at least two green trips per week
