DUI ARD ORDER

AND NOW, this _____ day of _____, 20____, the defendant is admitted into the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition (ARD) Program and is placed on Probation for a period of _____ months, subject to standard rules and conditions of probation, DUI conditions, all conditions of DUI/ARD Supervision and the following special conditions:

Defendant is directed to pay the fees and costs and restitution set forth in his/her application and agreement, and to otherwise abide by conditions set forth therein. Further proceedings on the underlying charges shall be postponed during the term of the ARD Program. The defendant's bail is terminated and any money or other form of security deposited is returned in accordance with the rules pertaining to bail. The following conditions shall also apply, if checked:

_____ Defendant's operating privileges shall be revoked for _____ months. The defendant is advised that if he/she drives at a time when his/her operating privilege is suspended or revoked as a condition of his/her acceptance to the ARD Program, he/she shall be guilty of an offense of Driving Under Suspension and sentenced to mandatory imprisonment and a mandatory fine. He/she could also be revoked from the ARD Program and, if subsequently convicted of the charges in this case, not receive any credit against any future driving suspension for the period of suspension served while in the ARD Program.

_____ Defendant shall not consume alcohol or any non-prescribed controlled substances while on the ARD program.

_____ Defendant has completed a CRN evaluation as directed by Probation Services.

_____ Defendant must pay restitution in the amount of \$ _____ to _____.

_____ Payments made by Defendant in this matter shall be applied to restitution prior to any other applicable fees and costs.

_____ Defendant must pay costs of prosecution as set forth in the application.

_____ Defendant must pay \$ _____ pursuant to Act 198 of 2002.

_____ Defendant must pay \$50 surcharge in accordance with 75 Pa. C.S. Section 6506.

_____ The Court accepts Defendant's attached ARD Admission Colloquy and finds that it has been knowingly and voluntarily made. Further, notwithstanding an order of expungement, records of this criminal case shall be retained in accordance with 75 Pa. C.S. §§ 1534(b), 1534(b.1), and 3807(f).

_____ The Defendant will be evaluated by the Adams County Department of Probation Services for participation in the automated Reporting System and, if deemed appropriate, shall participate in and pay any fees associated with said program.

**ACCELERATED REHABILITATIVE DISPOSITION PROGRAM: DUI
APPLICATION, AGREEMENT, MOTION AND ORDER**

I, the defendant above named, hereby apply for admission into the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program, hereinafter called the ARD Program, and hereby represent and agree as follows:

1. **Speedy trial and related rights:** I understand my right to have the criminal charges against me disposed of in a speedy manner. I also understand that provisions of Pa.R.Crim.P. 600 give me the right to have trial commence within 365 days from the date on which charges were filed against me, and that violation of speedy trial rights and/or the provisions of Rule 600 may give me the right to have all criminal charges dismissed. Further, I understand that prosecution of the charges will be postponed during my participation in the ARD Program and that the Commonwealth must be given the right to prosecute me if I am removed from the ARD Program some time in the future. In this regard, I understand the following:

a) if I violate conditions of the ARD Program, the court may remove me from the ARD Program and place my case back on the trial list.

b) if I am removed from the ARD Program, any delay caused by participation in and administration of the ARD Program will not be counted against the Commonwealth for Rule 600 and constitutional speedy trial provision purposes. I agree that if my trial begins beyond the time period permitted by the rule and constitutional provisions, I will give up any right to claim the benefit of speedy trial and Rule 600 provisions in regard to the time period during which I am on the ARD Program. I agree that I have waived my right to file any Omnibus Pretrial Motions under Pa.R.Crim.P. 578, both prior to my admission to the ARD program and, if applicable, in the event I am removed from the ARD program. In this regard, I understand that important rights may be given up or waived, represent that I am aware of and understand those rights, and voluntarily, knowingly and intelligently choose to waive or give up those rights. If I am, for any reason, refused admission after waiving such rights, my waiver shall be invalidated.

2. **Financial responsibilities:** As a condition of the ARD Program, I agree to pay the sum of \$ _____, in accordance with a payment schedule established by the Adams County Clerk of Courts. In addition, I understand that there may be extraordinary expenses associated with my case which are not included in the standard fee, however, which would constitute court costs as defined by statute and collectable by law. I agree that the Adams County Clerk of Courts may include these extraordinary costs as part of my financial responsibilities and agree to pay the same as a condition of my ARD admission. I acknowledge that failure to satisfy my financial responsibilities within the time period of my ARD admission shall be grounds for revocation and removal from the ARD Program and/or the initiation of contempt proceedings to be filed against me. I understand that this lump sum is comprised of various fees, charges, costs and perhaps restitution. I understand that money paid by me will be periodically distributed to various entities entitled thereto, and that it would be difficult for the Clerk of Courts to refund any money after distribution had occurred. I agree that I shall have neither a right of accounting nor refund as to any money paid by me, should I be removed from the ARD Program nor shall I be entitled to future credit. All money shall become the property of the entity entitled thereto,

as established by the Clerk of Courts. I agree that in addition to paying all ARD program fees, costs and expenses, I will also pay restitution and costs of prosecution as follows: Restitution: _____

Costs of prosecution: _____

I understand that the aforementioned restitution and/or costs of prosecution may only be estimates based upon information presently available. If the Commonwealth subsequently requests to amend these amounts, it shall provide me with written notice of the amount requested and give me the opportunity to agree or disagree with the request. If I agree, the request shall be submitted to the Court for entry of an amended order, but if I disagree the Commonwealth may request that the Court set the matter for hearing.

3. Probation: I understand that I shall be placed on probation for up to nine months, subject to standard rules and conditions of probation, DUI conditions, all conditions of DUI/ARD Supervision, and special conditions:

I acknowledge that the conditions have been explained to me and that I understand them and that violation of any condition shall constitute grounds for my removal from the ARD Program.

4. Successful completion: I understand that the charges against me will be dismissed if I successfully complete the ARD Program. However, if I am charged with Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and or Controlled Substances after my admission in the ARD Program, I understand that my participation in the ARD Program shall be considered a prior conviction for purposes of my driving record and more severe criminal penalties.

5. License Suspension: I understand that my operating privileges shall be revoked or suspended _____ month(s), and that I must comply with any in-patient treatment ordered by the court. Failure to do so shall be grounds for my removal from the ARD Program.

6. Removal from the Program: I understand that the District Attorney may request my removal from the ARD Program if I do not comply with the terms and conditions as described in this application. I waive the right to have the judge who placed me in the ARD Program rule on the Commonwealth's request and agree that any judge may decide the matter. I understand that a judge may order that process should issue for my arrest so that I would be produced and be given a chance to speak on the matter. I waive the right to be personally present and agree that a judge may remove me from the ARD Program, in my absence, if I have been given reasonable notice and an opportunity to appear.

7. Extensions: I understand that the statutorily authorized time for probation authorized by the rules for a DUI offense is twelve months. If I am, for any reason, unable to comply with the conditions of the ARD Program within the time of my probation, I understand that I may be given an opportunity to apply for consensual removal from and readmission in to the ARD Program. However, my readmission is at the sole discretion of the Commonwealth, is not a right, and must be approved by the Court. If I make such a request in the future, I agree that the acknowledgments and waivers I am presently making shall be incorporated into the request.

8. No prior Convictions or ARD or Pending Criminal Charges: In consideration for my admission to the ARD Program, I hereby affirm and acknowledge that I have not been convicted of nor arrested for a misdemeanor or felony criminal offense in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or in any other state or federal jurisdiction; that I have never been placed on the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program in this or any other jurisdiction; that I have not previously been admitted to a pre-disposition program similar to ARD in this or in any other state; that I have not been convicted of Driving Under the Influence or similar statute in Pennsylvania or another state or placed on the ARD program for Driving Under the Influence within the last ten years from date of this offense in Pennsylvania or in another state and that I do not have any pending misdemeanor or felony criminal charges pending in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or in any other state or federal jurisdiction. I understand that should this information be incorrect, that I may be removed from the ARD Program and,

further, that I may be prosecuted subject to the provisions of 18 Pa. C.S.A. Section 4904 relating to unsworn falsification to authorities. I further understand and agree that my obligation to disclose this information to the Commonwealth and the Court is continuous and ongoing up to and including the time that the Court admits me into the ARD Program. I further understand that should I be charged with a criminal offense as described in this paragraph while in the ARD Program, the Commonwealth may use this criminal offense as a basis to request the Court to remove me from the ARD Program.

9. Legally present in United States: In consideration for my admission into the ARD Program, I hereby affirm and acknowledge that I was legally present in the United States at the time I was charged with the offense and currently I legally reside in the United States. I understand that should this information be incorrect, that I may be removed from the ARD Program and, further, that I may be prosecuted subject to the provisions of 18 Pa. C.S. Section 4904 relating to unsworn falsification to authorities.

10. Bail: I understand that once the Judge grants my motion for entry into the ARD Program, bail shall be terminated and any money or other form of security deposited shall be returned to me in accordance with the rules pertaining to bail.

11. ARD Admission Colloquy: I understand that the ARD Admission Colloquy is a condition of eligibility for admission into ARD. I understand that I will be bound by the terms of the ARD Admission Colloquy, if relevant, at any future criminal proceeding, except as provided in 75 Pa. C.S. § 3807(g).

12. Expungement: I understand that it is my responsibility to pursue expungement and pay any necessary or applicable fees associated with expungement. I further understand that notwithstanding any order of expungement, records of this criminal case shall be retained in accordance with 75 Pa. C.S. §§ 1534(b), 1534(b.1), and 3807(f).

I hereby request the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to admit me into the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program.

The Adams County Court of Common Pleas has conditionally placed you under the supervision of the Adams County Department of Probation Services. You must comply with all supervision conditions set forth. If you violate any of these conditions of supervision, the Department of Probation Services has the authority to request an ARD Review Hearing to determine if the Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition Program remains an appropriate disposition.

DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE CONDITIONS

All persons admitted to the A.R.D. Program for any offense under Section 3802 (concerning Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs) shall be subject to all conditions set forth in 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 3807 including the mandatory license suspension imposed by that section.

In addition to the standard conditions of the A.R.D. Program, all persons admitted to the A.R.D. Program for an offense under Section 3802 are also subject to the following conditions:

1. You are prohibited from the consumption or possession of any alcoholic beverage while in the program;
2. Unless you are employed by the establishment and are present for work purposes, you may not enter or remain in any bar, tavern, or other drinking establishment. If employed by an establishment selling alcoholic or malt beverages, you must notify and obtain consent from the Department of Probation Services. However, this condition shall not prohibit presence in a restaurant facility provided presence is limited to the restaurant portion of the facility and no alcohol is present at the table or seating area where you are located. This condition also does not prohibit presence in grocery or convenience stores that have alcoholic beverages for sale.
3. You must successfully complete any recommended drug and alcohol treatment; and
4. You must successfully complete the Alcohol Highway Safety School safe driving program or other programs required by law.

ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

1. YOU MUST NOT:
 - a. use or possess non-prescribed controlled substances;
 - b. report to the Probation Office with alcohol on your breath or in your blood system. This includes reporting for the alcohol safe driving program.

TREATMENT

2. YOU MUST:
 - a. agree to have your person, blood, breath, or urine tested as directed by the Department of Probation Services or Prison officials;
 - b. attend counseling or therapy sessions related to drug and alcohol abuse as directed by the Court and comply with conditions of any treatment program recommended;
 - c. attend and comply with mental health counseling and therapy programs as directed by the Court and comply with conditions of that program; and
 - d. attend and comply with any counseling or treatment program related to domestic violence as directed by the Court.

PERSONAL CONDUCT

3. YOU MUST:

- a. not commit any violation of the law or violate the terms and conditions of any active protection from abuse order;
- b. report any contact with a law enforcement official or agency to the Department of Probation Services within the next business day. This includes any arrest, receipt of a criminal complaint, citation, or summons;
- c. not associate with persons having serious criminal records and reputations for criminal conduct;
- d. report to the Department of Probation Services when directed; including the automated reporting system, as deemed appropriate;
- e. obey all directions given by any Probation/Parole Officer;
- f. not commit any action which may cause fear, annoyance, or alarm to the victim of any case where charges have been filed against you; and
- g. obey a curfew from 12:00 a.m. (midnight) to 6:00 a.m. during which time you must remain inside your home unless otherwise required by employment conditions which are made known to your probation officer in advance or unless permitted otherwise in writing by the Department of Probation Services.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

4. YOU MUST:

- a. perform public service as directed by the Court. All community service shall be approved by the Department of Probation Services.

RESIDENCE

5. YOU MUST:

- a. notify the Department of Probation Services in advance of any changes of mailing address or physical residence or, if advance notice is not possible, within the next Court business day; and
- b. consent to the entry by a Probation/Parole Officer into your home at any time.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

6. YOU MUST:

- a. pay your debts, especially Court ordered, for the support of any person;
- b. pay all ARD costs, fines, and restitution no later than 45 days prior to the anticipated program end date on such payment plan as may be established by the Clerk of Courts Office;
- c. pay the costs of required counseling, therapy, and treatment; and
- d. pay the costs associated with the automated reporting system if deemed appropriate by the Department of Probation Services.

7. SPECIAL CONDITIONS: _____
