TITLE: Highway Incident Scene Safety and Management

DESCRIPTION: Students completing this course will be able to enhance responder and public safety at motor vehicle accidents and highway incidents. Learn how to implement responder safe work practices and create emergency operation work zones that enable restricted traffic movement wherever possible, avoiding full closures when feasible.
