### Subdivision and Land Development Report:

*SLD Submissions:* 13 SLD plans were submitted in July 2020, one of which was a resubmission. There were subdivisions, lot additions, and land development plans including:

- <u>Arrow's Pointe, Conewago Twp.</u> Single family residential subdivision with 89 proposed new units
- <u>The Lodges, Freedom Twp.</u> Proposed addition of 3200 sq ft event building and parking area to existing rural events venue
- <u>Knouse Foods Cooperative, Franklin Twp.</u> Conveying 31.08 acres from Knouse property to adjacent property
- <u>Chapel Meadows, Conewago Twp.</u> Single family residential subdivision with 167 proposed new units

*67/68 Submissions:* 2 67/68 land use consistency reviews were submitted in July 2020, including:

- Lowe/Pokorny Plan, Reading Twp. NPDES Stormwater/Construction
- Harvest Chapel, Berwick Twp. NPDES Stormwater/Construction

*Municipal/Misc. Reviews:* 4 municipal reviews and Comprehensive Plans/Misc. were submitted in June 2020, including:

- McSherrystown Borough Floodplain Ordinance
- SALDO amendment regarding lot addition language
- <u>Mount Joy Township</u> SALDO amendment regarding definition of land development and requirements for flag lots
- <u>Mount Joy Township</u> Zoning ordinance amendment to correct errors and omissions, flag lots
