1. Introductory Comments

Mr. Laughman called the meeting to order at 1:00pm.

Approval of Minutes: April 30, 2025

A motion was made to approve the January 22nd, 2025, ACTPO meeting minutes. the motion passed unanimously.

2. Staff Updates – ACO PD

- a. Mr. Merkel reported on Developments of Significance being proposed in the county. He stated there were 5 developments submitted, 2 being resubmissions (Kortney Meadows and Summerfield Final Ph 2).
- b. Mr. Merkel attended the following HOP, traffic study, and project meetings. Additional discussion followed on the various meetings.
 - PennDOT TIS Scoping Meetings
 - Gateway Boulevard HOP Agreement (Straban)
 - Project Meetings
 - Jacks Mountain Road Bridge (April)
 - York Freight Advisory Committee Meetings (February, March)
- c. Mr. Cameron provided an update on local bridge inspection activity. He noted that 2025 local bridge inspection program is underway. The local bridge maintenance contract documents are completed and under review, they should be going out soon.

3. Transit Updates

- a. Mr. Boyer provided an update on behalf of Commute PA:
 - Celebrating Earth Month (April) and Bike Month (May)
 - New Partner – Packaging Corp of America in New Oxford
 - Collaborating with @Home Adams County to establish a Bike Share program in Gettysburg
 - Active Bike Share across the 9 counties
 - Continuing Regional Congestion Management Process
 - SRTP received national accreditation from ACT
- b. Ms. Nidam provided an update on behalf of Rabbitransit. Sunday, May 4th the “Summer Schedule” goes live, extending the hours of the blue and gray line and returning the gold line to service. This schedule is live until the first Sunday in December.
