



## **PENNDOT VULNERABLE ROAD USER SAFETY ASSESSMENT SURVEY**

This survey is part of a broader consultation process being used by PennDOT to identify existing safety concerns for people walking and cycling and to recommend improvements that may alleviate those concerns. This process is focused on what the Federal Highway Administration calls “high-risk areas,” or areas with a high level of walking and cycling crashes. Equity measures and latent demand for walking and cycling were also taken into account in the identification of high-risk areas. The survey allows users to navigate to identified “high-risk areas” and provide comment about that area. The survey will be available for participation until 5:00 pm on Friday, September 8, 2023.
